


Preparation - assembly





Carefully unpack all the boxes. Sort the **individual parts** according to shape and size.




Tools - it is advisable to provide the necessary tools in advance. We recommend a hammer with a rubber head, a spirit level and a screwdriver, if available, a cordless screwdriver with the appropriate attachment (bit).








Basic structure - construction scheme






For easy **assembly**, construct the furniture from **left to right**. Start with the left outer side and connect it to the base. Assemble the furniture column by column.

Preparing components for assembly

Screw the structure connector dowels (V01) into the **sides**.


Press the structure connector housings(V02) and the wooden dowels(V05) into the **top and bottom shelves**.











Press the adapter plates and the **base feet** (V31) into the inverted base; we recommend using a hammer with a rubber head for this. **Attention:** The rounding on the adapter plates must face outwards.



A groove is provided on the base. The rail must be slid in and pushed out to install the skirting clips (V32).






You must press the shelf connector housings (V03) into the shelves. We recommend using a hammer with a rubber head for this.




From certain dimensions, panels can be separated into two elements and are connected with surface connectors (V06). Important Note: Tighten the connector housings (V02) gradually and alternately. Otherwise they may not grip properly.








Slide the **bottom panel** with the base feet to the left panel and fix the components by tightening the structure connector housings (V02).




Then place the **back panel** in the grooves.





Pay attention to the correct assembly sequence. First place the back panel in the groove of the left panel and the bottom panel, then the top panel and finally the right panel.




Slide the **top shelf** in place and fix the structure connector housings (V02).


Assembly - connecting the elements




To insert the **shelves**, screw the shelf connector dowels (V04) into the stringers and slide the shelf onto them from above. Then fix the shelf connector housings (V03).




To insert **shelves** into a **mounting strip with holes**, insert the shelf support (V07) into the stringers and slide the shelf on from above. **Important note:** One shelf must be fixed per column (as in step 5) so that your furniture has sufficient stability.

Assembly - adjusting and fixing




Align your furniture with the help of a spirit level. To do this, turn the plinth feet (V31) in and out.




After the furniture is level, slide the **base panel** with the clips (V32) onto the **base feet** (V31).

Assembly - adjusting and fixing






For **corner wardrobes**, it is important to install one after the other. Start with the wardrobe that is to be placed in the corner and then install the one that is to be placed next to it. After assembly, you can connect the two structures with dowels and connectors.



Once you have stabilised and leveled the furniture, attach it to the wall using the **antitip brackets** (V11). Use the screws for the furniture (V15) and the screws for the wall (V12) for this purpose.

Assembly - cover strips




Place the **cover strip** in the space between the furniture and the wall. Then drill and screw the cover strips from the inside. Use wood screws (V15) for this.

Attention: The screw heads are visible from the inside afterwards, if possible place the screws in inconspicuous places, for example at the top of a shelf.





For **doors and flaps**, insert the hinges (V13) and screw (V15) them in place.

Corner hinge




Interior hinge



When actioning this, make sure to choose the right **hinges**. Match the mounting positions of the fronts.

Insert the **mounting plates** (V14) with the arrow pointing forwards and fasten them by fixing the screws.



First place the hinges (V13) on the front edge of the mounting plate (V14). Then press the hinges firmly at the rear until the hinge engages.

Assembly - front components




Fasten the **handles** to the doors through the pre-drilled holes using the enclosed M4 screws (V18). **Important Note:** Use the shorter version of the screws (V18) for glass doors.






For **handles 2 or 3**, you can determine the position for yourself. Screw them in place at the back using the screws provided. The handles can also be mounted horizontally.



For **interior doors with a handle**, stop buffers (V08) are enclosed. Press them into the pilot holes.

Note: In the case of hinged doors, the stop buffers are fitted at the bottom edge of the door.




Furniture locks (V19) are pressed into the hole from behind and screwed into place. Press the key rosette from the front and then screw the locking bracket to the stringers or the shelf.


Note: For hinged doors, screw the striker bar to the opposite door.



Assembly - adjusting and fixing - opening mechanisms









To **adjust the doors** on your furniture, you can set the adjustment options on the hinges (V13) and the mounting plates (V14).


Note: Start with a front that you align to a stringer and adjust the other fronts to it.

Screw the **drawer runners** (V21) to the side panels of the furniture with the wood screws (V15). Use the first upper hole of the rails for the first hole in the item. The other fastening points can be found in the pre-drilled holes in the side panels.







The couplings (V20) are labelled R and L. When screwing on the couplings, make sure that they are aligned with the front edge. You can recognise the front edge by the additional holes.




- 1. Install the adjustment fittings (V22) in the front panel.
- 2. Use the screws (V18) to connect the front panel.



Insert the drawer into the furniture structure. You can now adjust the front panel: loosen the screws (V18) a little to move and adjust the front panel.

3. Use the screws (V16) to consolidate the assembly (see picture).




To then adjust the height of the drawer, push the control on the drawer coupling (V20) forwards or backwards.



Assembly - clothes rail / garment lift






Fix the **clothes rail brackets** in the holes provided, then hang the clothes rail.





Fasten the side arms into the pre-drilled holes with the screws provided, then place the clothes rail between the arms. Important Note: Fold out the arms to make it easier to insert the rod.

Assembly - interior drawer



To fit the **interior drawers**, first, insert the adjustment sides including the panels. Then position the top shelf.




Next insert the drawers.

Note: The recess and the panel enable the drawers to be opened without restriction, without bumping against the door or the hinges.

Assembly - vertical division



Vertical compartments are fixed with structure connectors. It is important here that the shelves are inserted correctly above and below. The structure connector dowels (V01) must be screwed in here. The connector housings (V02) must be inserted into the vertical dividing board and the whole assembly must be secured by pushing the two shelves together

Assembly - battery light




The **LED battery strips** are fixed without screws or fasteners. There is a self-adhesive magnetic tape on the top of the LED strips. For mounting, it is easiest to leave it on the LED strip. Measure the distance from the LED strip to the front edge of the shelf and the centre of the shelf.

Then peel off the adhesive protector and press the LED strip against the shelf.






The assembly is carried out using the **drilling template** supplied. Fold it at the folded edge and cut out the rhombus.




Place the side of the furniture where the bracket is to be mounted in front of you and mark the position in height on the front edge.

We recommend a minimum distance of 60 cm to the floor below and at least 5 cm to the shelf above.



Place the drilling template with the folded edge against the front edge of the floor and then push it to your mark. Fix the template with adhesive tape and drill through it.




To fix the bracket, remove the extendable part of the bracket and screw into the holes indicated on the rail. The drilling template only shows the first two drill holes. The other holes can be drilled through the rail using the marking shown. Finally, clip the extendable part of the bracket back on.






The assembly is carried out using the **drilling template** supplied. Fold it at the folded edge and cut out the rhombus.




Place the side of the furniture where the bracket is to be mounted in front of you and mark the position in height on the front edge.

Place the drilling template with the folded edge against the front edge of the floor and then push it to your mark. Fix the template with adhesive tape and drill through it.




Finally, you can fix the bracket with the screws provided.

Assembly - clothes hanger holder







You carry out the assembly with the **drilling template** supplied. Fold it at the folded edge and cut out the rhombus.



Position the panel on which the bracket is to be installed in front of you, then mark the middle of the panel on the edge (see picture)



Place the drilling template with the folded edge against the front edge of the floor and then push it to your mark. Fix the template with adhesive tape and drill through it.



Lastly, you can fix the pull-out by the front screws, then align and fix the pull-out at the back.
